ACT SUMMARY

- Designates the week that includes July 17 as "Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Week."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act designates the calendar week including July 17 as "Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Week."¹ A congenital diaphragmatic hernia is a birth defect that occurs when the diaphragm (the breathing muscle that separates the chest from the abdomen) develops a hole, allowing abdominal organs to move into the chest cavity and preventing lung growth.²
