ACT SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of Interstate 271, running in a northerly and southerly direction within the municipal corporation of Bedford Heights only, in Cuyahoga County, as the "Army Pvt. Brandon Sloan Memorial Highway."¹
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

Army Pvt. Brandon Sloan was killed in action on March 23, 2003, in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
