## ACT SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of State Route 8, located within the municipal corporation of Stow, commencing at the intersection of that route with Graham Road and proceeding in a northerly direction to the intersection of that route with Seasons Road, as the "Second Lieutenant David E. Rylander Memorial Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.<sup>1</sup>
