ACT SUMMARY

- Designates the week in May each year that coincides with Armed Forces Week as "Ohio Warrior Awareness Week."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act designates the week that coincides with Armed Forces Week as "Ohio Warrior Awareness Week" to encourage the observance of events recognizing the contributions of Ohioans in the Armed Forces. Armed Forces Week begins on the second Saturday of May and ends on the third Saturday. The third Saturday of May is Armed Forces Day.¹
