BILL SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of State Route 823 (scheduled to be completed not later than 2020), commencing at the intersection of S.R. 823 and U.S. Route 23 and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of S.R. 823 and U.S. Route 52 in Scioto County only, as the "Southern Ohio Veterans Memorial Highway."¹
- Designates a portion of State Route 41, commencing at the intersection of S.R. 41 and Rarden Road within Peebles and proceeding in a northerly direction to the intersection of S.R. 41 and the road known as Cemetery Road/Frog Hollow Road within Adams County only, as the "Specialist 4 Samuel A. Johnson Memorial Highway."²
- Designates the bridge that will span the Ohio River in Lawrence County and will replace the existing Ironton-Russell Bridge (scheduled to be completed in 2016), as the "Oakley C. Collins Memorial Bridge."³
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers on the roads and bridge designated above.
