CONTENT AND OPERATION

Manufacturing Month

The bill designates October as "Manufacturing Month." The purpose of this designation is to engage and inform students, parents, educators, media, customers, suppliers, and the general public throughout the region about, and improve the perception of, manufacturing careers and the value of manufacturing to the United States economy by increasing awareness, encouraging activities, and introducing real career opportunities, training, and resources.¹
