BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the calendar week that includes July 17 as "Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Week."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Week

The bill designates the calendar week including the 17th day of July as "Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Week."¹ A congenital diaphragmatic hernia is a birth defect that occurs when the diaphragm (the breathing muscle that separates the chest from the abdomen) develops a hole, allowing abdominal organs to move into the chest cavity and preventing lung growth.²
