## BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of United States Route 23, running in a northerly and southerly direction within Pike County only, as the "Captain Everett 'Butch' Keaton, Vietnam, SSM and BSM with OLC PH, Memorial Highway" (this designation is in addition to any other name prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise).
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.<sup>1</sup>

Army Captain Everett 'Butch' Keaton died on January 20, 1970, in Vietnam from injuries he sustained when an enemy ground explosive device detonated.
