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## BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of State Route 65, running in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction in Wood County between the intersection of that route and Rockledge Drive and the intersection of that route with Bates Road, as the "Staff Sergeant Bradley C. Hart Memorial Roadway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway indicating its name.<sup>1</sup>

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## COMMENT

Army Staff Sergeant Bradley C. Hart died on February 17, 2011, at his base in Djibouti, Africa, from injuries he sustained in a noncombat incident while performing his official military duties.
