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## BILL SUMMARY

- Creates the "I Love Grove City" license plate and requires the \$15 contributions that persons pay when obtaining the license plate to be paid to the Grove City Little League Board.
- Requires the Grove City Little League Board to use the contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth baseball fields within Grove City.

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## CONTENT AND OPERATION

### "I Love Grove City" license plate

The bill creates the "I Love Grove City" license plate, to which all of the following apply:

- (1) It is available to the general public;
- (2) It may be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law;
- (3) It must be inscribed with identifying words or markings that are designed by the Grove City Little League Board and are approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles; and
- (4) It is issued upon payment of the regular tax, any applicable local motor vehicle tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee, a Bureau of Motor Vehicles

administrative fee of \$10, a contribution of \$15, and compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.<sup>1</sup>

The Registrar must transmit the \$15 contributions to the Treasurer of State for deposit into the existing License Plate Contribution Fund. The Registrar then must pay those contributions to the Grove City Little League Board, which must use the contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth baseball fields within Grove City.<sup>2</sup> The Registrar must pay the \$10 BMV administrative fee, the purpose of which is to compensate the BMV for additional services required in issuing "I Love Grove City" license plates, into the state treasury for deposit into the existing State Bureau of Motor Vehicles Fund.<sup>3</sup>
