BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of state route 328 within Hocking County, commencing at the intersection of that route and United States route 33 and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of that route and state route 56, as the "Patrolman Carl "Shorty" Thrush Memorial Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Patrolman Carl "Shorty" Thrush, a member of the Ohio State Highway Patrol, died in the line of duty in 1972 from injuries he suffered when he was involved in a motor vehicle accident in Vinton County.
