BILL SUMMARY

- Creates the "Hospice and Homecare" license plate and requires the \$25 contribution that persons pay when obtaining the license plate to be paid to the Center for Community Based Care.
- Requires the Center for Community Based Care to use the contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in educating the residents of Ohio about the issues relating to hospice and homecare.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Hospice and Homecare license plate

The bill creates the "Hospice and Homecare" license plate, to which all of the following apply:

- (1) It is available to the general public;
- (2) It may be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law;
- (3) It must be inscribed with identifying words or markings that are designed by the Center for Community Based Care and are approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles; and
- (4) It is issued upon payment of the regular tax, any applicable local motor vehicle tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee, a Bureau of Motor Vehicles

administrative fee of \$10, a contribution of \$25, and upon compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.¹

The Registrar must transmit the \$25 contributions to the Treasurer of State for deposit into the existing License Plate Contribution Fund. The Registrar then must pay those contributions to the Center for Community Based Care, which must use the contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in educating the residents of Ohio about the issues relating to hospice and homecare.² The Registrar must pay the \$10 BMV administrative fee, the purpose of which is to compensate the BMV for additional services required in issuing "Hospice and Homecare" license plates, into the state treasury for deposit into the existing State Bureau of Motor Vehicles Fund.³
