## **BILL SUMMARY**

- Adopts the Adena Pipe as the official state artifact of Ohio.

## **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

### **Adena Pipe**

The bill adopts, as the official state artifact, the artifact known as the Adena Pipe, which is a prehistoric effigy pipe that was discovered in 1901 by William C. Mills within a burial mound near Chillicothe, and that was created by the ancient Adena culture (800 B.C. to A.D. 1)<sup>1</sup> from native Ohio pipestone.<sup>2</sup>
