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## BILL SUMMARY

- Establishes the Course and Program Sharing Network to be administered by the Chancellor of the Board of Regents.
- Requires the Network to consist of course-share programs developed through agreements among Ohio economic development organizations and other nonprofits approved by the Chancellor, colleges, universities, and adult career centers.

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## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill establishes the Course and Program Sharing Network to be administered by the Chancellor of the Board of Regents. The Network must consist of course-share programs that share existing curricula, increase course availability, and avoid unnecessary course duplication. The programs must be developed through agreements among Ohio economic development organizations and other nonprofits approved by the Chancellor, colleges, universities, and adult career centers. The bill requires the Chancellor to develop administrative rules and procedures for course-share programs and the Network.
