## BILL SUMMARY

- Makes an appropriation from the GRF to provide state matching funds for federal TRIO programs at state institutions of higher education.

---

## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill appropriates an amount from the GRF to provide additional funding for eight federal TRIO programs in the state. The funds are to be disbursed in a manner determined by the Board of Regents to match federal funds received for the programs by state institutions of higher education. The eight TRIO programs are as follows: Talent Search; Upward Bound; Upward Bound Mathematics/Science; Veterans Upward Bound; Student Support Services; Educational Opportunity Centers; Ronald E. McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement Programs; and Training Program for Federal Trio Programs Staff.<sup>1</sup>

The federal TRIO programs are outreach and student services programs designed to identify and provide services for low-income individuals, first-generation college students, and individuals with disabilities to enable them to progress from middle school to post-baccalaureate programs.<sup>2</sup>
