BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the first week of October as "Ohio Forest Products Awareness Week."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the first week of October as "Ohio Forest Products Awareness Week" in order to educate the public about, increase public awareness of, and recognize contributions of Ohio's forests and forest products industry to the state's economic viability and the quality of life of its citizens and to recognize the forest products industry's environmentally responsible stewardship of Ohio's forest resources.¹
