BILL SUMMARY

- Requires the headlights on any motor vehicle to comply with federal headlamp color requirements (a white light) and specifies that failure to comply with the requirement is a minor misdemeanor.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill requires the headlights on any motor vehicle to comply with the federal headlamp color requirements established in regulations governing motor vehicle safety standards. These standards require headlamps to be white.¹ Any person who operates a motor vehicle in violation of this requirement is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.²

Rules adopted by the Department of Public Safety, currently require motor vehicle headlamps to display a white light.³
