## **BILL SUMMARY**

- Designates the portion of Interstate Route 670 running through the municipal corporation of Columbus in Franklin County, between Fourth Street and Interstate Route 70, as the "Dana G. 'Buck' Rinehart Highway."
- Designates a portion of State Route 13, commencing at the intersection of that route with Cassel Road in Knox County and proceeding in a northerly direction to the intersection of that route with Zolman Road, as the "William Burgett Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the above highways indicating their names.<sup>1</sup>

Buck Rinehart served as mayor of Columbus from 1984 to 1992.

William Burgett is the founder of the Kokosing Construction Company.
