# **Ohio Arts Council**

- · Primarily GRF-funded
- Overall funding increase of 1.5% in FY 2018 and flat funding in FY 2019
- GRF supports \$12.7 million each fiscal year in grants for artists and arts organizations

#### OVERVIEW

#### **Agency Overview**

The Ohio Arts Council (OAC) promotes the visual and performing arts in Ohio through cultural and educational activities and by providing economic assistance in the form of competitive grants to artists, art organizations, and communities. OAC awards grants that support arts learning and education, long-term community vitality, and cultural diversity, among other purposes. It also operates the Riffe Gallery in downtown Columbus and oversees acquisitions for the state's Percent for Art Program, which places artwork in buildings financed by state capital funds. The Council consists of 19 uncompensated members, 15 of whom are appointed by the Governor and four of whom are nonvoting legislative members, two appointed by each chamber. The Council appoints an executive director, who manages the agency's daily operations and oversees 16 positions, including program coordinators, grants coordinators, and other administrative and support staff.

#### **Appropriation Overview**

As shown in the table below, the budget appropriates \$16.5 million in both FY 2018 and FY 2019, an increase of 1.5% from FY 2017 spending of \$16.2 million. OAC derives 89.1% of its funding from the GRF. Of this funding, 86.9% is used by OAC to award competitive grants. OAC also receives funding through various sources that support the expenses of the specific programs offered and the Percent for Art Program, all of which represent 3.3% of OAC's appropriations. In addition to these sources, OAC receives funding from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA). These federal grants comprise 7.6% of the budget.

#### **Operating Expenses (370321)**

This line item supports expenses including payroll and fringe benefits as well as supplies, maintenance, rent, and equipment costs. The budget appropriates \$1.9 million in each fiscal year, a 5.1% increase over FY 2017 spending of \$1.8 million.

#### **State Program Subsidies (370502)**

This GRF line item supports grant programming for artists and arts organizations, including for purposes related to arts learning and education, long-term community vitality, and cultural diversity, among others. The budget appropriates \$12.7 million in each fiscal year, a decrease of \$373,967 (2.9%) from the FY 2017 spending level.

#### **Arts Council Program Support (370602)**

This line item supports a small portion of the operating expenses of OAC as well as a portion of the cost associated with management of the Riffe Gallery, located at the Vern Riffe Center in downtown Columbus. The remainder of the Riffe Gallery's budget is supported by GRF line item 370321, Operating Expenses. It also supports expenses related to the ArtsinOhio.com online event finder and the annual Governor's Awards for the Arts in Ohio, among other activities. Funds for this line item are received from various sources that support the expenses of the specific programs offered, including

intrastate transfer vouchers from the Department of Administrative Services for operation of the Riffe Gallery, contributions from the convention and visitors bureaus in Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus, and Toledo to manage ArtsinOhio.com, and Governor's Awards for the Arts in Ohio advertisement sales. The budget appropriates \$325,000 in each fiscal year for these purposes.

#### Percent for Art Acquisitions (370603)

This line item is used to pay for OAC's costs related to the Percent for Art Program, which provides for the purchase, commission, and installation of original artwork in new or renovated public buildings, including new university structures, that are financed by at least \$4 million in state capital dollars. Of the capital costs for each eligible state building project, up to 1% is set aside for the acquisition of artwork under Percent for Art. Of this 1% set-aside, 7% may be used for OAC's administrative costs with respect to the program. Moneys appropriated in this line item support costs associated with the selection of artists for specific projects, such as travel, printing, honoraria, and other expenses of jurors and artists. It also supports a small amount of payroll for OAC staff. OAC may also use this line item to acquire art, though it has not done so in recent years. The budget appropriates \$225,000 in each fiscal year for this line item.

#### Federal Support (370601)

This line item is used to make grant awards for a variety of purposes through a federal grant from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA). NEA awards are based on two primary criteria: (1) a formula based on population and (2) a competitive award based on merit in arts education, underserved persons, and folk arts. In each of the past seven years, Ohio has received the second highest NEA total award in the country behind California. The budget appropriates \$1.25 million in each fiscal year for this line item, a 25.2% increase from FY 2017 spending of \$1.0 million. The budget contains a temporary law provision requiring the funds in this line item to be used by OAC for subsidies only, and not for its administrative costs, unless specifically required to use a portion of the funds for administrative costs under conditions of the federal grant.
