- In FY 2020, Ohio's per-pupil operating expenditures were \$310 (2.3%) higher than the U.S. average.
- Increases from FY 2011 to FY 2020:
 - 23.0% Ohio per-pupil operating expenditure;
 - 27.2% U.S. average per-pupil operating expenditure;
 - 16.4% CPI.
