
## Main operating budget authorized 94.3% of total state spending in FY 2022

- In FY 2022, state spending, including both operating and capital spending totaled \$90.05 billion.
- The main operating budget (H.B. 110 of the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly) authorized \$84.95 billion (94.3%).
- The transportation budget (H.B. 74 of the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly) authorized \$3.71 billion (4.1%).
- The Bureau of Workers' Compensation and the Ohio Industrial Commission each has its own budget. Together these budgets authorized \$317.9 million (0.4%) of total spending.
- Capital spending authorized by the capital appropriations bill (S.B. 310 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly) authorized \$1.08 billion (1.2%).
