1 Subject: Telecommunications and Computer Services ContractsR.C. *125.021*R.C. *125.021*

Precludes the Department of Administrative Services from operating, superintending, or making contracts on behalf of the Industrial Commission for telephone, other telecommunication, or computer services. The Industrial Commission may opt, however, to have the Department of Administrative Services contract on its behalf.

No change.

Fiscal effect: The Industrial Commission is permitted discretion with respect to contracting for telecommunications and other computer services. A potential exists for both savings and higher expenditures, depending upon the service contracts into which the Commission enters.

Over the biennium, \$12,232,932 has been appropriated for this purpose.</p>	<p>Section: 3</p> <p>No change.</p>
<p>3 Subject: Service Account Section: 3</p> <p>Requires that moneys in appropriation item 845-605, Service Account, be used for expenses related to revenues collected and deposited to this account. These expenses may include the purchase of copiers, copier maintenance and supplies, coin copier expenses, coin changer purchases, conference expenses, publications expenses, and replacement of furniture and equipment.</p>	<p>Section: 3</p> <p>No change.</p>
