Legal Basis: ORC 4732.08 and 4743.05; Section 369.10 of H.B. 49 of the 132nd G.A. (originally established by H.B. 152 of the 120th G.A.)

Purpose: This line item is used to pay the State Board of Psychology's operating expenses, including personal services, supplies, maintenance, and equipment. The Board licenses and regulates psychologists, school psychologists (those not regulated by the Department of Education), and applied behavior analysts. The Board also establishes standards of practice, investigates complaints, holds administrative hearings, determines appropriate disciplinary actions, and monitors continuing education compliance among its licensees.
