**Legal Basis:** Discontinued line item

**Purpose:** This line item was used to support the general operating expenses, including payroll, supplies, and equipment, for the State Barber Board. The Board was responsible for licensing barbers, barber teachers, barber shops, and barber schools, with renewals occurring on a biennial basis in odd-numbered fiscal years. Funding for FY 2018 carried the Board through January 21, 2018, when its licensing and enforcement operations were consolidated with those of the State Board of Cosmetology under the re-named State Cosmetology and Barber Board. The combined operations are funded under Fund 4K90 appropriation item 879609, Operating Expenses.
