Source: General Services Fund Group: License fees are received by the board in several categories relevant to the dentistry profession. Types of licenses include those applicable to dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants, teachers of the dentistry practice, teachers of radiology used in dentistry, and sponsors of general anesthesia/conscious sedation courses. License fee revenue is deposited into Fund 4K9.

Legal Basis: Sections 39 of Am. Sub. H.B. 94 of the 124th G.A.; and ORC 4715.03, 4715.031, 4715.13, 4715.14, 4715.16, 4715.21, 4715.24, and 4714.27 (originally established by Am. Sub. H.B. 152 of the 120th G.A.)

Purpose: This appropriation supports the Ohio State Dental Board which licenses and regulates the practice of dentistry, dental hygiene, and dental assistant radiography in the state. Funds from this line item are used for general operating expenses, including payroll, supplies, and equipment.
