### Budget Analyst/Economist

The Ohio Legislative Service Commission has an opening on its fiscal staff for a budget analyst/economist. Subject areas include Health Care/Medicaid and Human Services. A graduate degree in economics and/or experience in health care/Medicaid analysis and forecasting are preferred. Salaries start at high-\$40,000, but may be higher depending on relevant experience.

**Job Duties:** Budget analysts/economists are assigned one or more agencies/subject areas. Major duties include analyzing a bill's fiscal effects and preparing a fiscal note for the bill, responding to legislative research requests for information on fiscal issues related to state and local government, preparing various budget documents to assist the General Assembly in enacting biennial state budgets; and staffing committees to help answer any fiscal questions committee members may have.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Graduate degree in economics, public policy, public administration, or related field; superior research, analytical, and writing skills; ability to communicate in a concise, timely, and effective manner; and demonstrated Excel spreadsheet skills.
