

Legislative Service Commission Directory of Fellows

This directory lists individuals who worked as legislative fellows as part of the long-standing Legislative Service Commission legislative fellowship program. The directory is arranged by year, and former fellows are listed alphabetically within each year of the fellowship program. Directory entries are based on responses to a questionnaire sent to former fellows, so some entries provide more detail than others. Entries list each former fellow's name, a photograph if available, the university and the degree(s) received prior to becoming a fellow, the most current business address available, and any comments included about the fellowship program.

Until 1971, the fellowship program followed the academic year beginning in the fall and ending in July of the following year. Since 1971, the program has begun in early December and ended on December 31 of the following year, more closely matching the legislative year.

In May 2010, the program was renamed the LSC Legislative Fellowship Program from the LSC Internship Program to more accurately reflect the educational and professional goals of the program.

The number of fellows listed varies from year-to-year due to additional fellows being hired to fill vacancies as well as the Commission's decision to periodically change the number of fellowships based on available program funds.

Upon completion of the LSC fellowship, many fellows attend graduate or law school. These post-fellowship achievements are not listed in the directory unless included in the fellow's comments. LSC does include this information in the LSC Fellowship database.

Printed copies of the Directory of Fellows are available to former fellows. Unlike the Internet version of the directory, the printed version includes home addresses and phone numbers for fellows who responded to this project as long as they authorized their inclusion.
