These moneys will be used for emergency repairs and planning to the more than 280 buildings and structures operated by the Society. The priority repairs are for waterproofing and maintaining the structural integrity of the buildings. The Society has indicated that many of the facilities, which were built during the 1960s and 1970s have approached the end of their useful lives. Staff estimate that the funding levels should increase each biennium by \$50,000 to meet the needs of the aging buildings.

Am. Sub. H.B. 790 of the 120<sup>th</sup> General Assembly appropriated \$300,000 in GRF funds and \$160,000 in Arts Facilities Building Fund (Fund 030) moneys through the then Arts Facilities Commission for emergency repairs; Am. H.B. 748 of the 121<sup>st</sup> General Assembly allocated another \$350,000 in GRF moneys and \$150,000 in Fund 030 moneys; and Am. Sub. H.B. 850 of the 122<sup>nd</sup> General Assembly appropriated \$500,000 in GRF funds for the emergency repairs.
