CAP-766	Construct Security Building At Entrance (Franklin)	New Construction	\$129,863

OSD will construct a security building at the main (Morse Rd) entrance to the school. The existing fire alarm monitoring station will be transferred to this building. OSD security staff will be better able to control and regulate the entry of visitors and deliveries to the campus and to prevent unauthorized access to the campus from this location.

CAP-767	Roof Renovations (Franklin)	Renovation/ Replacement	\$1,500,000

Roof renovations are necessary in many buildings, many of which are 46 years old and have incurred water damage. The majority of the roofs on the campus buildings already have two layers of roofing materials. Both layers need to be removed before a new roof can be installed. These renovations would help protect the buildings and their contents and help ensure drier and more energy-efficient working and living conditions. Without these repairs, the buildings would continue to degrade.

OSD received funding for roof renovations in the previous capital budgets of \$1,173,900 (CAP 221-96-015 and CAP-730).

CAP-768	Dormitory Furniture Replacement (Franklin)	Capital Equipment	\$297,077

This project will enable OSD to replace its living room furniture in its dormitories. OSD has eleven dormitories, all recently renovated. The living room furniture in the dormitories is currently twelve years old and has outlived its 10-year life expectancy. Many pieces are worn and damaged beyond repair.

CAP-769	Emergency Exits Improvements (Franklin)	Renovation/ Replacement	\$26,163

OSD will construct ADA compliant ramps for the emergency exits of its dormitories, administration building, and school building. OSD has been systematically bringing the campus up to ADA standards. Although many entrances to campus buildings have been made ADA compliant, a number of emergency egress doors are still inaccessible.

CAP-770	Install Perimeter Fence Along Morse Road (Franklin)	New Construction	\$155,952

This project will add a security gate and perimeter fence along the school's Morse Road property line to prevent unauthorized foot and vehicular access to the OSD campus, thus enhancing the overall security of the students, staff, and buildings.

**Master Plan**

The Department of Administrative Services has been appropriated \$250,000 to complete a master plan for the School for the Deaf and the School for the Blind to suggest ways the two schools, which are adjacent to each other, could better share facilities. This report is to be completed by June 30, 2001.
