CAP-010 Sandusky State Theatre Improvements **\$325,000**

Category: Community Project(s)

County: Erie

These funds will be used for continuing theatre renovations. Previous appropriations for this project include \$1,000,000 in H.B. 675 of the 124th General Assembly, \$200,000 from Am. Sub. H.B. 640 of the 123rd General Assembly, \$500,000 from Am. Sub. H.B. 850 of the 122nd General Assembly, and \$150,000 from Am. Sub. H.B. 790 of the 120th General Assembly. The theatre is located in Erie County and has served as a downtown Sandusky performance center since 1928.

CAP-013 Stambaugh Hall Improvements **\$250,000**

Category: Community Project(s)

County: Mahoning

These funds will be used to continue renovations to this 2,600-seat auditorium which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Built in the 1920s, it is located in Youngstown, Ohio, and is a popular spot for many cultural activities and community events. Previous appropriations for this project include \$200,000 in H.B. 675, \$500,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 640, \$600,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 790, and \$625,000 in state appropriations from Am. Sub. H.B. 850.

CAP-033 Woodward Opera House Renovation **\$100,000**

Category: Community Project(s)

County: Knox

This opera house located in Mt. Vernon is one of the oldest theatres in the United States and was constructed around 1853. It is managed by the Knox County Performing Arts Coalition. This funding is for renovations and upgrades for the complete rehabilitation project, which encompasses four floors including the theatre, retail, and commercial office space. Previous appropriations include \$250,000 in H.B. 675, \$250,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 640, and \$250,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 850.

CAP-038 Center Exhibit Replacement **\$816,000**

Category: Other

County: Franklin

Specific project information is not available at this time. A previous appropriation of \$750,000 was granted in H.B. 675. These funds were used to replace sections of the current history mall at the Ohio Historical Society with smaller galleries containing exhibits of topical interest. The funds were used to design, fabricate, and install "Ohio's Garden Path," an exhibit showcasing Ohio's gardens, and research and design an exhibit about the 1950s that is scheduled to open in the fall of 2005. The smaller galleries provide greater flexibility in the exhibit program by allowing exhibits to be updated more often and creating an environment for repeat audience visitation and broader education planning.

CAP-043 Statewide Site Repairs **\$100,000**

County: Statewide

The line funds Ohio Historical Society projects around the state.

CAP-044 National Underground Railroad Freedom Center **\$4,150,000**

Category: Community Project(s)

County: Hamilton

The center will document and commemorate the history of the Underground Railroad - a network of South-to-North routes for individuals escaping the bonds of slavery in the mid-1800s. These funds will continue state assistance for this centerpiece of Cincinnati's Central Riverfront Development. It is in close proximity to the sports facility projects in Cincinnati. Previous appropriations for this project include \$4,000,000 in H.B. 675, \$3,500,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 640, and two appropriations of \$133,333 and \$500,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 850.

CAP-046 Cincinnati Museum Center Improvements **\$250,000**

Specific project information is not available at this time. Previous appropriations for this project include \$1.6 million in H.B. 675, \$200,000 from Am. Sub. H.B. 640, and \$525,000 from Am. Sub. H.B. 850.

CAP-052 Akron Art Museum **\$1,012,500**

County: Summit

Based upon the recommendations of the feasibility study that reviewed options to address the museum's space limitations, the museum will expand its current 24,890 square foot location to 80,000 square feet. Funds will continue with this project, which will allow greater display of the museum's paintings, sculpture collection, and photography holdings. The Akron Art

Museum specializes in regional, national, and international art from 1850 to the present. Previous appropriations were \$1,500,000 in H.B. 675, \$2,500,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 640, \$100,000 of GRF and \$1,100,000 of bond funds in Am. Sub. H.B. 850.

**CAP-053 Powers Auditorium Improvements-Eleanor Beecher
Flad Pavilion** **\$250,000**

County: Mahoning

Specific project information is not available at this time. Previous state appropriations to the Powers Auditorium were \$200,000 in H.B. 675, \$500,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 640, and \$250,000 from Am. Sub. H.B. 850. Previous funds were used for renovations to the Powers Auditorium. It is home to the Youngstown Symphony Orchestra and serves as a facility for artistic performances, meetings, and celebrations.

CAP-065 Beck Center for the Cultural Arts **\$100,000**

County: Cuyahoga

The funds will be used for renovations at the Beck Center for the Cultural Arts. A previous appropriation of \$100,000 was made in H.B. 675 of the 124th G.A.

CAP-069 Cleveland Institute of Art **\$250,000**

Specific project information is not available at this time. A previous appropriation of \$750,000 was made in H.B. 675 of the 124th G.A. These previous funds were used for planning and development costs related to the Institute's campus consolidation. The Cleveland Museum of Art was established in 1882.

CAP-071 Cleveland Institute of Music **\$750,000**

Specific project information is not available at this time. A previous appropriation of \$750,000 was made in H.B. 675 of the 124th G.A. The Cleveland Institute of Music used these funds to expand the Institute's existing facility in order to retain and attract top students to the Northeast Ohio area, retain faculty, and remain one of the nation's top conservatories.

CAP-073 Marina District/Ice Arena Development **\$3,500,000**

County: Lucas

This appropriation item will be used toward the construction of a new arena for a minor-league hockey team. The Marina District will combine retail, commercial, and residential development at this location. A previous appropriation of \$4,000,000 was made in H.B. 675 of the 124th G.A.

CAP-074 Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens **\$750,000**

County: Summit

Specific project information is not available at this time. A previous appropriation of \$250,000 was made in H.B. 675 of the 124th G.A. These funds were used toward the restoration of the estate's water management system.

CAP-745 Emergency Repairs **\$838,560**

County: Statewide

This project will make emergency repairs to some of the more than 300 buildings and structures that are part of the State Memorial system and administered by the Ohio Historical Society. These buildings include major museum facilities as well as archaeological and historical sites and buildings. In general, these projects are often unanticipated and usually include preserving the waterproof and structural integrity of the State Memorial system's infrastructure as well as the replacement of heating and air conditioning equipment.

CAP-769 Rankin House State Memorial **\$192,000**

Category: New Construction & Renovation

County: Brown

These funds will provide renovations to the Rankin House State Memorial.

CAP-781 Archives/Library Automation **\$624,000**

Category: Capital Equipment

County: Franklin

Specific project information is not available at this time. In H.B. 675, the project was appropriated \$300,000. These moneys were used by the Ohio Historical Society to process state and local government records and archaeology, audiovisual, history, manuscript, and natural history collections and make them ready for public use. These records will become part of the online collections catalog and serve as online finding aids. Hardware and software supporting the online collections catalog were upgraded, allowing the Society to provide more and better access to descriptions and images of collections.

CAP-784 Center Rehabilitation **\$960,000**

Category: Renovation/Replacement

County: Franklin

Specific project information is not available at this time. Previous funding of \$741,000 was received in H.B. 675. These funds were used for the first phase of the project and included physical upgrades for visitor services to the plaza level, miscellaneous physical upgrades to the main level for both employees and patrons, upgrades to HVAC and fire and safety systems, and new site signage. The second phase of the project will continue the renovations of the first phase with emphasis on improvements to fire and security system upgrades.

CAP-806 Grant Boyhood Home Improvements **\$480,000**

A project description is not available at this time. Previous funding of \$68,333 was received in H.B. 675.

CAP-812 Schuster Arts Center **\$5,500,000**

Category: Community Project(s)

County: Montgomery

The Benjamin & Marian Schuster Center for the Performing Arts, formerly known as the Dayton Performing Arts Center, will include a 2,300-seat theater, rehearsal space, a black box theatre, and a winter garden. Previous appropriations for this project were \$10,000,000 in H.B. 675 and \$9,500,000 in Am. Sub. H.B. 640.

CAP-823 Marion Palace Theatre **\$750,000**

Category: Community Project(s)

County: Marion

The Marion Palace Theatre, built in 1928, was designed by theater architect John Ebersson. Funds will be used to construct an addition to the west side of the building. The addition will include a new lobby, concession area, restrooms, and catering kitchen. The additional space will also provide for uses such as reception and meeting rooms, a convention center, or class space for the community. A previous appropriation of \$825,000 was made in H.B. 675. Those funds have been earmarked for construction purposes, and will be combined with the new appropriation of \$750,000.

CAP-826 Renaissance Theatre **\$750,000**

The vision of the Richland Performing Arts Association is to create a community performing arts center, which will incorporate the existing theatre. The center would include an expanded Renaissance Theatre, a new "black box" theatre, and rehearsal space. A previous appropriation of \$50,000 under H.B. 675 went toward the construction of a new parking lot. New funding will be used toward additional facility renovations.

CAP-834 Galion Historic Big Four Depot Restoration **\$170,000**

The City of Galion recently purchased the former New York Central Depot to preserve this unique part of Galion's history. Restoration of the Galion Historic Big Four Depot commenced in the spring of 2004. Together with a previous appropriation of \$50,000, these funds will be used to make improvements to the facility, including the stabilization of the building's structure and roof repairs.

CAP-835 Jamestown Opera House **\$125,000**

The Jamestown Opera House was built in 1889 by Jamestown Village and Silvercreek Township. The Opera House was the center of community activities until the Silvercreek Centralized School opened in 1937. Funds will assist with the renovation of the Opera House to restore it as a center of community activities. Window replacement and exterior brick renovation were funded in part by a \$100,000 appropriation made under H.B. 675. Future renovations include the installation of new electrical, heating and air systems, and replacing and installing the original doors to the front of the building.

In March 2002, Lima Stadium was placed on the National Register of Historic

Places. Funding will be used toward renovations to the stadium.

Following the attack on Pearl Harbor in 1942, the federal government commissioned the engineering of a radio installation powerful enough to reach a global audience. By 1944, the first Voice of America station capable of reaching out to the world was in operation in West Chester, Ohio. Known as the "Bethany Station," it began broadcasting to the world in 53 languages. Bethany Station was decommissioned in 1995 and the facility, together with approximately 500 surrounding acres, was transferred to Butler County MetroParks and West Chester Township for public use. Today, plans are underway to convert this 25,000-square-foot facility into a memorial park and museum dedicated to the Voice Of America's unique history. Funds will be used for renovations at the facility.

CAP-848 Oxford Arts Center ADA Project **\$72,000**

The Oxford Community Arts Center is located on Miami University campus in the Oxford College building. The facility provides for a wide range of performances, workshops, social functions, and community events. Restoration of the house has been sponsored by the Westcott House Foundation, and the work to date has been meticulous, with attention given to every detail, from the color of roof tile to the texture of interior walls. The project is now entering its final stages and the grand opening of the restored Westcott House is scheduled to take place in September of 2005. Funding under H.B. 16 will be used toward these final stage restorations.
