*County:* Multi-County

This funding is directed toward programs that seek to find ways to burn clean Ohio coal with fewer emissions in a manner that meets federal clean air standards. Previously, the funds existed within Ohio Air Quality Development Authority's budget, but H.B. 153, the main operating budget act for the FY 2012-FY 2013 biennium, transferred the Ohio Coal Development Office to the Department of Development.

The Ohio Coal Development Office oversees the Ohio Coal Research and Development Program, which provides two types of grants on a cost-share basis: (1) research and development grants to educational and scientific institutions for studying emissions formation and methods of control, and (2) demonstration and pilot project grants to firms or universities for discovering new technologies or applying existing technologies in an environmentally acceptable manner. Since FY 2007, The Office has spent approximately \$57.7 million on initiatives funded through the Coal Research and Development Program.
