These funds will be used for a number of projects on the Ohio State School for the Blind (OSB) campus. They involve: (1) replacement of 60-year old, single-pane windows and frames, (2) replacement of the current, 35-year old boiler system heating the OSB pool (used as part of the school's adaptive physical education program) with an energy efficient hot water heating system, (3) for the lower level of the old OSB school building, removal of asbestos-laden vinyl composition tiles (VCTs) and asbestos-laden mastic glue, installation of new VCT flooring, and radon remediation, (4) remodeling portions of the old OSB school building to provide office and work spaces for various OSB departments that will need to relocate due to the closing off and mothballing of the primary wing of the school building, (5) installation of fire lanes around existing OSB buildings to ensure emergency vehicles have sufficient access to all buildings on the campus, and (6) production of a feasibility study to plan for the future demolition of certain existing buildings on the OSB campus, many of which share common electrical, HVAC, fire, telecommunications, and utilities systems or infrastructure.
