HIGHER EDUCATION IMPROVEMENT FUND (7034)

C23501 Ohio Supercomputer Center **\$6,000,000**

County: Franklin

These funds will support various projects at the Ohio Supercomputer Center (OSC), which manages the OSCnet that provides internet services to colleges and universities, K-12 schools, academic medical centers, and public television stations. Projects supported with these funds include completing infrastructure investments, expanding current-generation service hardware, and deploying next-generation "early adopter" clusters. Previous capital appropriations for OSC include \$12.0 million in H.B. 497, \$2.0 million in H.B. 482, \$2.0 million in H.B. 562, \$0.2 million in H.B. 699, \$6.8 million in H.B. 16, \$8.5 million in H.B. 675, \$6.5 million in H.B. 640, and \$14.3 million in H.B. 850.

C23502 Research Facility Action and Investment Funds **\$1,000,000**

County: Statewide

These funds are used for a grant program that provides timely availability of capital facilities for research programs and research-oriented instructional programs at or involving state-supported and state-assisted institutions of higher education. Specifically, the funds provide matching capital funds for equipment or facilities for research institutions seeking research grant awards from federal and other external entities. Ohio's research institutions include 13 public universities, one public university of medicine, Case Western Reserve University, and the University of Dayton. The minimum capital commitment match from DHE is \$60,000. Overall, the minimum total budget for a project must be at least \$250,000, with a capital budget of at least \$120,000. Previous appropriations include \$3.5 million in H.B. 497, \$3.9 million in H.B. 482, \$5.5 million in H.B. 562, \$5.5 million in H.B. 699, \$5.0 million in H.B. 16, \$19.0 million in H.B. 675, \$20.0 million in H.B. 640, and \$20.0 million in H.B. 850.

C23516 Ohio Library and Information Network **\$13,415,000**

County: Statewide

These funds primarily support the annual acquisition of the latest digital library content for the OhioLINK membership. Specifically, the funds subsidize the cost of high-quality electronic journal and database content that OhioLINK institutions rely on for research and training, with a large portion of the purchased content focusing on science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and medicine (STEMM) disciplines. OhioLINK subsidizes about 20% of the purchased content with capital funds, and the OhioLINK membership pays the remaining 80%. Also, \$500,000 is allocated to upgrade and enhance the OhioLINK central catalog and migrate the existing Electronic Book Center to a new commercial platform for delivering OhioLINK's eBooks. Previous appropriations include \$12.0 million in H.B. 497, \$9.0 million in H.B. 482, \$9.9 million in H.B. 562, \$5.4 million in H.B. 699, \$8.1 million in H.B. 16, \$8.2 million in H.B. 675, \$7.5 million in H.B. 640, and \$6.5 million in H.B. 850.

C23524	Supplemental Renovations - Library Depositories	\$1,150,000

County: Statewide

These funds support basic renovations at the five regional library depositories, which allow the largest university libraries to store less used materials in off-site facilities. The original facilities are now more than 20 years old and are in need of major and minor repairs such as roof and boiler replacements and equipment repair and replacement. The facilities are located on the campuses of Bowling Green State University, Miami University, NEOMED, Ohio University, and the Ohio State University. Previous appropriations include \$2.0 million in H.B. 497, \$2.0 million in H.B. 482, \$5.5 million in H.B. 562 and \$2.0 million in H.B. 699.

C23529	Workforce Based Training and Equipment	\$8,000,000

County: Statewide

These funds will be used for the Regionally Aligned Priorities in Developing Skills (RAPIDS) program, the purpose of which is to support collaborative projects among higher education institutions to strengthen education and training opportunities that maximize workforce development efforts in defined areas of the state. The grants provide capital funds on a competitive basis to Ohio regions or subsets of regions. Previous appropriations include \$8.5 million in H.B. 497, \$2.0 million in H.B. 482, and \$2.4 million in H.B. 562.

C23530	Technology Initiatives	\$2,500,000

County: Franklin

These funds are used for needed technology infrastructure improvements. The priority projects in the FY 2017 - FY 2018 biennium will be the continued upgrade of the Higher Education Information (HEI) system for the Department of Higher Education and the Electronic Journal Center for OhioLINK. In addition, \$350,000 of the funds will be used to purchase hardware and software to enhance data security. Previous appropriations for this line item include \$4.5 million in H.B. 497, \$3.1 million in H.B. 482, \$3.7 million in H.B. 562, \$2.0 million in H.B. 699, \$3.7 million in H.B. 675, \$10.0 million in H.B. 640, and \$10.0 million in H.B. 850.

C23532	OARnet	\$9,100,000

County: Statewide

These funds are used to support the OSCnet network that interconnects Ohio's colleges and universities with each other as well as with national commercial and academic networks. This appropriation includes funding to replace outdated equipment, complete a backbone connection between Athens and New Philadelphia, complete the State of Ohio Computing Center-Cologix interconnect, and carry out the first phase of a project to increase network security. Previous appropriations include \$7.0 million in H.B. 497, \$2.0 million in H.B. 482, \$2.0 million in H.B. 562, \$5.0 million in H.B. 699, \$4.5 million in H.B. 16, and \$5.0 million in H.B. 675.

C23551	Research Portal	\$1,650,000

County: Statewide

These funds will be used for Phase II of a project to develop a centralized portal that showcases the research expertise of Ohio's university faculty and identifies institutional research equipment available in the state. Phase II includes procuring the technological capability to improve the research database (constructed in Phase I during the FY 2015-FY 2016 biennium) with searchable, collaborative, and other highly interactive functionality. In addition, the vender will work with higher education institutions to fully automate the process of collecting data, which will facilitate the process of efficiently adding additional faculty and equipment to the database. H.B. 497 appropriated \$500,000 for Phase I of this project.

C23560	HEI Critical Maintenance and Upgrades	\$7,200,000

County: Franklin

These funds will be used for the ongoing maintenance and upgrade of the Higher Education Information (HEI) system. More specifically, \$3.0 million of the funds will be used for equipment to maintain the current system, while \$4.2 million will be used for additional staff or contractors to plan for the implementation of a comprehensive rewrite of the HEI system. In mid-2014, a team of business analysts identified the current usage requirements for all data collected by DHE and developed detailed findings to address discovered deficiencies and future system needs. As a result of these findings, it was determined the first step would be for OH-TECH and DHE to stabilize the current environment before entering the HEI rewrite phase of the project.

These funds will be used for specific capital needs at Central State University, including, but not limited to, the repairs and renovations needed to fully address the condition of the Hallie Q. Brown Memorial Library. Previous appropriations include \$19.0 million and \$14.0 million for the Student Activity Center in H.B. 482 and H.B. 562, respectively, and \$1.0 million for emergency capital needs in H.B. 699.

These funds will be used to restore the remaining façade elevations of the Auburn Science and Engineering Center. The Center houses over 405,000 square feet of academic and research space.

C25057 Electrical Infrastructure - Loops \$2,400,000

County: Summit

These funds will be used to replace the center campus' deteriorated 4,160 volt cable and duct bank with a 23,000 volt loop and duct bank. In addition, the funds will provide alternate feeds to Exchange Street and South Hall Student Residences, creating a secondary loop, and replace deteriorated transformers in Bierce Library and Crouse Hall.

C25065 Akron Battered Women's Shelter \$750,000

County: Summit

This line item provides funding for a community project.

C25066 Roof Replacements \$811,000

County: Summit

These funds will be used to replace roofs on the Lincoln Building, the Roadway Building, the James A. Rhodes Arena football annex and women's locker room, and Ayer Hall.

C25067 Underground Vaults/Mechanical - Phase 2 \$350,000

County: Summit

These funds will be used for the complete replacement of deteriorating utility vaults on the Main campus.

C25068 Polsky Exterior Façade and Renovations \$1,775,000

County: Summit

These funds will be used to restore the terra cotta façade of the Polsky Building. Other projects include painting and repairing the canopy, landscaping, and signage.

C25069 Campus Hardscape \$1,000,000

County: Summit

These funds will be used to replace or renovate various walkways, streets, steps, and ramps around the Main campus.

These funds will be used to upgrade cabling and network infrastructure. The current cabling is over 30 years old and network components range from 10 to 15 years old.

C24045	Allied Health and Sciences Building - Firelands	\$847,500
<i>County:</i>	Erie	

These funds will be used to finance the final phase of the proposed Allied Health and Science Building. Originally, the project had been planned as a new 40,000 square foot classroom and laboratory building, housing the Allied Health and Biological Sciences departments. Instead, BGU decided to renovate two existing buildings as follows: North Building - a two story addition of nearly 17,000 square feet and approximately 20,000 square feet of renovated space to accommodate the core science curriculum in support of the biology, physics, anatomy, and physiology and chemistry programs and West Building - nearly 17,600 of renovated space to include the nursing, radiologic technology, diagnostic medical sonography, and the respiratory care technology programs.

Previous appropriations for this project include \$1.0 million in H.B. 497, \$0.9 million in H.B. 482, \$0.9 million in H.B. 562, and \$1.0 million in H.B. 699. The overall project cost is estimated at \$15.8 million, of which \$9.8 million will be provided by the university.

C25515	Information Technology Network and Infrastructure	\$3,447,000
<i>County:</i>	Greene	

These funds will be used to renovate and upgrade CSU's IT network and infrastructure. These renovations and upgrades include: virtualizing the server farm hardware and upgrading server software, upgrading the infrastructure virtualization system, replacing the campus portal and student email systems, upgrading fiber cable and replacing failing copper cables, installing a second core router and firewall, replacing the outdated uninterruptible power supply (UPS) system, updating the campus security protection system, replacing old air conditioning system in the computer room, replacing hardware for faculty and staff and computer laboratory, upgrading cell-phone service by installing cellular repeaters on buildings throughout campus, replacing the CISCO phone system, and establishing a virtual laboratory environment.

C25516	Campus-wide Chillers and HVAC Replacements	\$1,503,350
<i>County:</i>	Greene	

These funds will be used to overhaul and update CSU's air conditioning and air handling systems. This project completes an effort to make learning facilities on campus more comfortable and energy efficient. In March 2015, CSU completed a project that included the installation of 36 new boilers across campus.

<i>County:</i>	Hamilton	

This line item provides funding for a community project.

C26676	Health Professions Building Rehabilitation	\$11,000,000
<i>County:</i>	Hamilton	

These funds will support the continued renovation of the Health Professions Building (HPB). HPB, originally built in 1916, includes 118,000 gross square feet of lab, office and teaching space. The renovated structure will serve primarily the College of Pharmacy along with other functions of UCN's Academic Health Center. The project includes, but is not limited to, abatement, selective demolition, renovations to the building structure and exterior envelope, window replacement, interior modifications, and new finishes, furnishings, and equipment. The total project is estimated at \$30 million.

C26684	Whole Home Modifications Phase II Falls Prevention Center	\$250,000
<i>County:</i>	Hamilton	

This line item provides funding for a community project.

C26694	Rieveschl Roof Replacement and Rooftop Exhaust	\$6,800,000
<i>County:</i>	Hamilton	

These funds will be used for the removal and replacement of the roof on Rieveschl Hall, including the replacement of deteriorated and failing roof-top fans. The project will also replace a greenhouse on the roof with one about one-half the size.

C26695	Rhodes Hall Roof Replacement and Fire Suppression	\$7,000,000
<i>County:</i>	Hamilton	

These funds will be used to replace the roof on Rhodes Hall, including deteriorated and failing roof-top fans, and install fire protection throughout the building. The project will also create a fire separation on all floors of Rhodes Hall, as well as a connected building, Baldwin Hall. The total project cost is estimated to be \$8 million.

C26696	Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music Infrastructure Replacements	\$7,000,000

County: Hamilton

These funds will be used for Phase I of a two-phase project to replace electrical and performance system infrastructure in buildings operated by the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music (CCM). More specifically, Phase I work will replace electrical and theater sound systems, connect communications and production systems in various auditoriums and theaters, and replace stage rigging and structures supporting audio visual equipment and stage lighting. The total project cost is estimated to be \$15 million.

C26697	Vontz Center Roof, Panel, and Window Replacements	\$4,427,129

County: Hamilton

These funds will be used to correct water damage and the source of leaks and to replace the roof and windows of the Vontz Center for Molecular Studies, which opened in 2000. The total project cost is estimated to be \$11 million.

This line item provides funding for a community project.

These funds will be used for the first of a several phase project that will replace obsolete and failing building infrastructure and update Muntz Hall's interiors. The scope of this phase of the project includes vertical infrastructure renovations; installation of new ceilings, lighting, and life safety and fire alarms; and, complete removal and replacement of existing mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems with new high performance and energy efficient systems. The project will also replace the last remaining portion of roof for the Muntz building. The estimated total cost of this phase of the project is \$8.7 million.

C26069 Cleveland Institute of Art \$200,000

County: Cuyahoga

This line item provides funding for a community project.

C26072 Fenn Hall Addition \$14,600,000

County: Cuyahoga

These funds will be used for facility improvements and construction of a 100,000 square foot addition to the Fenn Hall building, which currently houses the Washkewicz College of Engineering. The addition will replace Chester Hall, which is connected to Fenn Hall and is beyond its useful life. The addition will provide CLS with state of the art laboratories, classrooms, and an engineering learning environment. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$58 million. Phase I of the project, which has already commenced, will include the demolition of Chester Hall and construction of the four-story, 100,000 square foot addition. Phase II will include the buildout of the remaining 40,000 square feet not finished in Phase I, replacement of the Fenn Hall West roof and façade, windows, and curtain wall.

C26073 School of Film, Television, and Interactive Media \$7,500,000

County: Cuyahoga

These funds will be used for a project to renovate and build a new location for the School of Film, Television, and Interactive Media, which is currently housed in the Music and Communication Building. The school's new facility will be located in a remodeled space on CLS's main campus and will include a motion picture production laboratory, audio recording and editing facilities, and cloud-based editing technologies.

C26074 CWRU Health Education Campus \$1,000,000

County: Cuyahoga

This line item provides funding for a community project.

County: Portage

These funds will be used to replace the 20 year-old, original fume exhaust system located in the Liquid Crystal and Materials Science Building. The new system is expected to minimize energy consumption and maximize efficiency by monitoring both the hood face velocity and the room occupancy, reducing the exhaust and make-up air needs appropriately.

C270F7	Rockwell Hall Electric Chiller and Air Handling Replacement	\$1,500,000

County: Portage

These funds will be used to address two major deferred maintenance issues in Rockwell Hall, home of the School of Fashion Design: (1) the replacement of the 38-year-old chiller and (2) the replacement of the 25-year-old rooftop air handling unit.

C270F8	Taylor Hall Renovations - Visual Communications and Design	\$7,000,000

County: Portage

These funds will be used to renovate Taylor Hall to become the future home of the School of Visual Communications Design (VCD). The project will replace remaining aging infrastructure and will provide improved ADA access to complete the building rehabilitation, which included renovations for the nearly completed Center for Architecture and Environmental Design. In addition to renovating the academic spaces, this project will complete the preservation of this historic building that also houses the May Fourth Visitor Center.

C270F9	Bowman Hall Mechanical and Building Improvements	\$5,000,000

County: Portage

These funds will be used to provide general building renovations to address deferred maintenance in Bowman Hall, which was constructed in 1962 and houses numerous departments and centers. Projects will address failing air conditioning, plumbing, and power systems as well as ADA and future program requirements.

C270G1 Terrace Hall Renovations - College of Public Health \$3,000,000

County: Portage

These funds will be used for the renovation of the second floor of Terrace Hall for laboratory and space needs associated with the growing and newly accredited College of Public Health. The College was established in 2009 to educate and train students to meet the current and projected shortage of public health professionals in Ohio and the nation. The projects supported by these funds will focus mostly on outstanding deferred maintenance issues, including the replacement of failing mechanical and electrical systems.

C270G2 Satterfield Hall - HVAC \$500,000

County: Portage

These funds will be used to complete the replacement of the original HVAC system in Satterfield Hall. Portions of the HVAC system have been replaced and modernized over the past 10 years.

C270G3 Campus Fire Alarm System Replacements \$900,000

County: Portage

These funds will be used to address specific life and safety system concerns on campus, such as obsolete and non-compliant fire alarm systems. Specifically, the project will include inspecting existing campus fire alarm systems, prioritizing the most critical work, and beginning a phased replacement of the most pressing systems. The new fire alarm systems will be compliant with the ADA and the latest fire code requirements.

C270H4 Akron General Sexual Assault Evidence Collection and Care Facility \$500,000

County: Summit

This line item provides funding for a community project.

C270G4 Main Classroom Building Renovations, Wing B - Ashtabula \$325,000

County: Ashtabula

These funds will be used to renovate selected areas in the B-Wing of Main Hall, which is a two-story building constructed in 1967. Improvement of the approximately 27,625 square foot area will primarily focus on converting the original auditorium into a modern lecture facility. Other projects include updating interior finishes, student restrooms, and the HVAC system and extending the building's fire suppression system from the previously renovated A-Wing into the B-Wing.

C270G5 Purinton Hall HVAC Upgrades - East Liverpool \$450,000

County: Columbiana

These funds will be used to address deferred maintenance associated with the Purinton Hall HVAC systems. Specifically, the project will replace the existing rooftop air handling unit and, possibly, the interior fan and coil air conditioning units serving portions of the building.

These funds will be used to replace the original high-pressure sodium parking lot and sidewalk light fixtures with high-efficiency LED fixtures. OSU-Newark will also provide funds for this project.

C36918 Founders Hall Renovation Planning - Newark \$450,000

County: Licking

These funds will be used for the planning and design for a variety of improvements and upgrades to Founder's Hall. Projects may include an overhaul of the existing building mechanical system, life and safety system improvements, upgrades to existing academic classrooms and laboratories, and façade restoration. OSU-Newark will also provide funds for these projects.

C36919 Hopewell/Reese Emergency Generators - Newark \$375,000

County: Licking

These funds will be used to purchase and install emergency back-up natural gas generators at Hopewell Hall, the Facilities Operations Building, and the Reese Center. OSU-Newark will also provide funds for this project.

These funds will be used for the planning and design work associated with a renovation of COT's Pataskala Campus facility.

C36323 Equestrian and Veterinary Workforce Facilities Renovation \$2,000,000

County: Athens

This project will renovate and upgrade the equestrian educational facilities on the main campus. The renovation addresses deferred maintenance, makes minimal functional improvements to existing facilities, and provides new ancillary facilities to improve the instructional environment. The renovated facilities will enhance the health and safety of the students, faculty, and equine population in terms of life safety, fire protection, and increased accessibility to instructional environments. The improvements will also address needed indoor riding environments during inclement weather and unsuitable trail conditions.

C36324 Dental Hygiene Workforce Facilities Renovation \$1,000,000

County: Athens

These funds will be used for a renovation of Shaw Hall that will allow HTC to expand health science programs and add a dental hygiene program on campus that provides opportunities for both classroom and practical instruction as well as dental care for the local community.

C38100 Basic Renovations \$610,000

County: Allen

These funds will be used for basic renovation projects around campus, which may include landscaping, painting, minor construction projects, new furniture, and general repairs.

C38110 Center of Health Science Education and Innovation \$250,000

County: Allen

These funds will be used for planning and design for a Center of Health Science Education and Innovation in Lima, Ohio. Development of the center is a collaborative effort between LTC, the City of Lima, businesses, and other organizations designed to integrate existing healthcare initiatives with health care industry business partners to facilitate new business, develop new programs, and provide for a common strategic direction. The center is expected to allow for simulations, virtual laboratories, clean rooms, and high-tech laboratory equipment and provide services to underserved residents.

C38117 IT Infrastructure \$550,000

County: Allen

These funds will be used for continued updates to the campus computing infrastructure, which may include refreshing LTC's data center with new servers and storage, expanded wireless device coverage and bandwidth, remote data backup, or additional IT security.

C38118 Road and Parking Resurfacing \$350,000

County: Allen

These funds will be used to resurface parking areas on campus to improve driving surfaces.

C38119 Completion Plan Outcome - Toolbox \$100,000

County: Allen

These funds will be used to implement the Completion Plan Toolbox, a set of tools to be incorporated into LTC's institutional strategic planning process to improve student retention and completion rates. Among other benefits, the tools will allow the college to more easily connect with remote students. The tools consist of Cranium, a Scheduler in Canvas, Report Writer, SharePoint, and Orientation on Line.

C38120 Boiler Replacement - Countryman \$120,000

County: Allen

This project will replace the boiler in the Countryman building that has reached the end of its useful life.

C38121 Reed Hall Renovations \$225,000

These funds will be used for renovations to Reed Hall, which currently houses the cafeteria, OSU Theatre, and OSU Music Faculty. The renovations will focus on achieving energy cost savings.
