HIGHWAY SAFETY FUND (7036)

C76035	Alum Creek Facility Renovations and Upgrades	\$1,200,000

County: Franklin

This capital appropriation of \$1.2 million funds phase one of a planned two-phase project to upgrade the fire protection and alarm systems at the Alum Creek Facility, which was built in 1968. The project's total estimated cost is \$3.2 million.

C76036	ShIPLEY Building Renovations and Improvements	\$1,500,000

County: Franklin

This appropriation funds two projects at the Shipley Building, which serves as the Department of Public Safety's headquarters. The first project, with a total estimated cost of \$750,000, consists of security enhancements, including an upgrade to the security control center, modernization of the building's original fire alarm system, and exterior security enhancements (vehicle barriers, planters, bollards, security fencing, and gates).

The second project, with a total estimated cost of \$2.25 million, will be a two-phase energy efficiency upgrade. This capital appropriation will cover phase one's estimated cost of \$750,000, which includes lighting and HVAC upgrades, as well as potential upgrades to the roofing and windows. Phase two is estimated to require an additional \$1.5 million.

C76043	Minor Capital Projects	\$2,500,000

County: Multi-County

This capital appropriation funds various maintenance projects at the 56 posts that are owned and operated by the Ohio State Highway Patrol. The projects, many of which are for necessary, but unforeseen, repairs and improvements, include roof repairs and replacements, new windows, electrical and HVAC system repairs, and parking lot replacement and repairs.

C76044	OSHP Headquarters/Post Renovations and Improvements	\$2,250,000

County: Multi-county - Ashtabula, Trumbull

This capital appropriation funds renovations at two Ohio State Highway Patrol facilities: (1) the Warren District Headquarters located in Trumbull County, and (2) the Ashtabula Post located in Ashtabula County. The Warren District Headquarters project will include upgrading the electrical system, upgrading fire exits, restructuring office areas in the basement and first floor, and addressing Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. The Ashtabula Post project will include renovation to address foundation issues.

C76045 OSHP Academy Renovations and Improvements \$1,250,000

County: Franklin

This capital appropriation funds renovations and improvements at the Ohio State Highway Patrol Training Academy, specifically the remodeling and expansion of the facility's kitchen and dining space.

C76046 OSHP - K-9 Training Facility \$1,250,000

County: Franklin

This capital appropriation funds, in cooperation with the Ohio Expositions Commission, renovation of a building at the Ohio Expo Center for use by the Ohio State Highway Patrol as a K9 training facility. The project will include eight to ten kennels with indoor and outdoor runs, a classroom facility, a dormitory to house students, and outdoor space for tracking, article search, and reasonable force training.
