



This capital appropriation will fund two projects at the Bureau of Criminal Investigation laboratory facility located in Richfield. The first project involves the purchase and installation of a new humidity control system in the criminal laboratory, the total cost of which is estimated at \$197,208. The second project involves the purchase of equipment and necessary work to increase electrical generator capacity to provide a more reliable backup in the event of power failures. The total estimated cost of the project is \$97,244.

**C05523 Security Improvements \$355,387**

*County:* Multi-county - Madison, Summit

This capital appropriation will be used to pay for security improvement/enhancement projects at facilities of the Office of the Attorney General located in London and Richfield. One of the planned projects involves upgrading the security at Ohio Peace Office Training Academy facilities located in London and Richfield, with the total cost of the scope of work estimated at \$305,837. The London work will enhance the existing surveillance and monitoring system (new cameras and alarms, and additional card access readers). The Richfield work also includes enhancing the existing surveillance and monitoring system (new cameras and alarms, new software and access controls, and re-wiring), as well as the installation of physical barriers.

The other planned projects involve upgrading the security at the Bureau of Criminal Investigation's London location. One of the projects, estimated to cost \$39,760, involves the physical "hardening" of the reception and lobby area (bullet proof glass and partitioning access to secured areas). A second project, estimated to cost \$9,790, will enhance security in a vehicle garage that has been repurposed into an evidence receiving area and storage facility. The work includes adding cameras, laser motion sensors, biometric technology, and card access readers.
