**C00502    General Building Renovations** **\$8,373,883**

This capital appropriation will fund two renovation projects at the Thomas J. Moyer Ohio Judicial Center, located at 65 South Front Street in Columbus, which houses the Supreme Court of Ohio. The first project, with a total estimated cost of \$6.6 million, involves major exterior renovations, including marble cladding repairs, reflecting pool restoration and repair, plaza stone and masonry repairs, copper troughs repairs, and the replacement of a number of large original windows (c. 1932).

The second project, with a total estimated cost of \$3.5 million, involves mechanical-HVAC renovations, including the replacement of two absorption chillers with centrifugal chillers and modular hydronic boilers and the installation of additional relief dampers. The project's cost will be funded with \$1.8 million from this capital appropriation plus another \$1.7 million from reappropriated capital money.
