Legal Basis: originally established by H.B. 322 of the 119th G.A.

Purpose: The cap was raised from \$5,000 to \$30,000 by H.B. 152 of the 119th G.A. The Cosmetology Board received Controlling Board approval to increase the spending authority to \$30,000 in November 1994. The Board requested the increase to use the funds for printing and mailing information to all licensees concerning repeated violations and the enforcement fine system. The Board may impose fines of up to \$100 per violation. Effective FY 1998, this line is transferred to 879-609, Operating.
