Legal Basis: Section 20 of Am. Sub. H.B. 94 of the 124th G.A. and ORC 4766.05 (originally established by Sub. S.B. 98 of the 119th G.A.)

Purpose: This appropriation supports the activities of the Ambulance Licensing Board, which includes the licensing and regulation of all private ambulance companies operating in the state. Funds in this line item are used to pay the board's administrative costs, including payroll, maintenance, and equipment.
