COSCD1 License to Operate a School of Cosmetology

R.C. 4713.44, 4713.08, 4713.641

(1) Requires the State Board of Cosmetology to adopt rules to establish the manner in which a licensed school of cosmetology may offer post-secondary and advanced practice programs, or both.

(2) Requires a school of cosmetology, in order to qualify for a license to operate, to establish and maintain an internal procedure for processing complaints filed against the school and for providing students with instructions on how to file a complaint directly with the Board

(3) No provision.

(3) Establishes a complaint process that students and former students of a cosmetology school may use to file a complaint with the Board alleging a violation of the Cosmetology Law by the school. Requires the Board to initiate a preliminary investigation on the complaint and follow hearing and notice requirements under Chapter 119. if it is probable that the school has committed a violation.

Fiscal effect: The State Board of Cosmetology could incur costs to investigate and follow up on student complaints under the provision.
