FMJCD1 Ohio Military Facilities Commission as a subcommittee under the Federal-Military Jobs Commission

(1) Establishes the Ohio Military Facilities Commission created under the House-Passed bill (see MFCCD1) as a subcommittee of the existing Federal-Military Jobs Commission (FMJC) responsible for developing and implementing a program to finance or assist in the financing of infrastructure capital improvements on military and defense installations in the state.

(2) Specifies that the Ohio Military Facilities Commission subcommittee consists of the following five members: two members of the House, chosen by the Speaker of the House; two members of the Senate, chosen by the President of the Senate; and one member designated by the Governor. (The House-Passed version provided for nine members.)

(3) Requires the subcommittee to develop an application process for financial assistance under the program.

(4) Allows financial assistance under the program to be in the form of grants, loans, loan guarantees, or rental or lease payments that enable new construction.

(5) Requires the subcommittee to (A) review applications and make recommendations to FMJC for the approval of projects and (B) upon approval by FMJC, oversee the distribution of awards under procedures adopted by the subcommittee and approved by FMJC.

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FMJCD2 Projects under the Federal-Military Jobs Program

Authorizes FMJC to designate projects as eligible federal-military projects, establishes an application process for designation as eligible federal-military projects, and allows FMJC to designate regional economic development entities for technical or administrative assistance with the application process. Includes FMJC projects, programs, and activities as eligible projects for economic development assistance.

Requires FMJC to establish criteria for evaluating proposals and designating projects as eligible federal-military projects by January 31, 2016, and lists 13 criteria that FMJC may include in evaluating proposals.

Requires FMJC to develop and implement plans for encouraging local support for the federal-military jobs program and for eligible federal-military projects.

Expands the classifications of obligations in which the Treasurer of State may invest or execute transactions for any part or all of the interim funds of the state to include obligations issued by political subdivisions relating to eligible projects overseen by the Federal-Military Jobs Commission.

Allows a political subdivision to enter into an agreement with the Treasurer to provide for the purchase of investment-grade obligations under the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement. Specifies certain requirements related to such agreement.

Allows a political subdivision to pay a reasonable fee to the Treasurer as consideration for the Treasurer's agreement to purchase the obligations. Requires that such fees be

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deposited into the State Political Subdivision Obligations Fund. Prohibits usage of money from the GRF to subsidize the purchase or resale of such obligations.

FMJCD3 Appropriations for Ohio Military Facilities Support

Transfers \$2.5 million cash in each of FY 2016 and FY 2017 from the Economic Development Programs Fund (Fund 5JC0) to the Federal-Military Jobs Fund (Fund 5RR0).

Requires Fund 5RR0 appropriation item 128602, Ohio Military Facilities Support, to be used for projects described under sections 193.15 and 193.16 of the Revised Code. (See FMJCD1)

Fiscal effect: Appropriations for this purpose were provided under the budget of the Ohio Military Facilities Commission (MFC) in the House-Passed version of H.B. 64. (See MFCCD2)

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MFCCD1 Role of the Ohio Military Facilities Commission

Establishes the Ohio Military Facilities Commission for the purpose of developing and implementing a program to finance or assist in the financing of infrastructure capital improvements on military and defense installations in the state.

Replaces the House provision with one that creates the Ohio Military Facilities Commission as a subcommittee under the existing Federal-Military Jobs Commission responsible for developing and implementing a program to finance or assist in the financing of infrastructure capital improvements on military and defense installations in the state. (See FMJCD1)

Specifies that the Commission consists of the following nine members: three members of the House (two from majority, one from minority); three members of the Senate (two from majority, one from minority); the Adjutant General or the Adjutant General's designee, the Director of Budget and Management or the Director's designee; and the Director of Administrative Services or the Director's designee. Requires the Development Services Agency to provide administrative assistance to the Commission.

Specifies that the financial assistance the Commission provides may be in the form of grants, loans, and loan guarantees. Also allows the Commission to provide assistance in the form of rental or lease payments that enable new construction.

Requires the Commission to examine an application for assistance to determine if the proposed infrastructure capital improvement will (1) support job creation, (2) increase opportunities for long-term economic development, or (3) increase the military value of the installation as described in section 2913 of the "Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990, as amended. Specifies that only those

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improvements that meet at least one of these three criteria are eligible for financial assistance under the program.

MFCCD2

Ohio Military Facilities Support

Requires GRF appropriation item 232501, Ohio Military Facilities Support, to be used for the duties of the Ohio Military Facilities Commission.
