
Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill would prohibit the Bureau of Motor Vehicles from issuing a driver's license that bears the social security number of the license holder. The current driver's license contains the license holder's social security number.

The Bureau is currently in the process of updating their computer programs to make it possible to assign permanent driver's license numbers to individuals obtaining an Ohio driver's license. Under the current system, license numbers are not permanently assigned to an individual.

Since the Bureau is already in the process of updating their computer systems, no additional programming expenditures are associated with the bill's provisions. Additionally, any costs associated with the removal of the social security from the face of the drivers license are anticipated to negligible.
