- The placement of markers by the Department of Transportation (ODOT) is permissive. There are a total of 16 possible sites. Thus, at a cost of \$200 per sign, ODOT could incur a maximum cost of \$3,200.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on local governments.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill designates U.S. Route 33 (see map) as the "Marine Corps League Memorial Highway", and allows the Director of Transportation to erect markers along the highway indicating this designation. Since the placement of such markers is permissive, the Department of Transportation (ODOT) may or may not incur costs. According to a spokesperson for ODOT, there are eight rest areas along the route (16 considering both sides of the highway) at which signs could be placed. Should the Department place signs at each possible designation, at \$200 per sign, the most cost that ODOT could incur would be \$3,200.

Existing law also designates this route as the "Blue and Grey Trail", however, the bill repeals this designation.

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
