- The placement of markers by the Department of Transportation (ODOT) is permissive. The Department has indicated that a maximum of two signs would be placed at an estimated cost of \$200 per sign.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis


The bill designates the portion of State Route 125 that runs in an easterly and westerly direction through Clermont County as the “Edward J. Parish Highway”. The Director of Transportation would be permitted to erect markers along the highway indicating this designation. Since the placement of markers is permissive, ODOT may or may not incur costs. Initially, it appears that there would be only two signs placed by ODOT. Signs cost about \$200 each, therefore, the total cost is estimated to be \$400.
