### **John Kalamán and Robert O'Toole Memorial Highway**

The bill designates Interstate Route 675, located in Montgomery, Greene, and Clark counties and running in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction as the "John Kalamán and Robert O'Toole Memorial Highway". The Director of Transportation would be permitted to erect markers along the highway indicating this designation. Since the placement of markers is permissive, ODOT may or may not incur costs. Initially, it appears that there would be only two signs placed by ODOT. Signs cost about \$200 each, therefore, the total cost is estimated to be \$400.
