Detailed Fiscal Analysis

There would be no mandatory cost on any level of government for declaring February 1st of each year Ohio Township Day. The bill encourages township officials to use this day to visit the schools to explain their duties and qualifications. Any expenses for these and other promotional activities would be discretionary and would likely be small.
