Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill gives the Director of Transportation discretion with regard to posting signs indicating the highway's name. Federal law regulates the placement of such signs, which generally provides for placement in rest areas, scenic overlooks, and turnouts. According to a spokesperson for the department, there are four areas along the highway suitable for sign placement. One sign at each location at a cost of \$200 each would be a total cost to the Department of Transportation of \$800.
