The bill would make several changes to Ohio's Probate Laws, which will have no direct fiscal effect on either the state or local governments. Provisions in the bill regarding trusts, wills and the determination of present values in probate matters do not have direct fiscal effects upon any unit of government in Ohio. The main focus of the bill is to set probate law in conformity with Ohio's Estate Tax Law.
