Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

This bill would change the date of the primary election held in presidential election years from the third Tuesday in March to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in March. Sub. S.B. 150 of the 120th General Assembly changed the date of the primary election in presidential election years from May to March. Primaries in non-presidential election years would still be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May.

This bill also eliminates the requirement that those who want to become a member of the county central committee of a political party file a petition signed by five qualified electors. These persons need only file a declaration of candidacy.

This bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or any political subdivisions.
