
Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill would change the name of the Police and Firemen's Disability and Pension Fund to the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund and the name of the Firemen and Policemen's Death Benefit Fund to the Ohio Public Safety Officers Death Benefit Fund. It further stipulates that any references to the Police and Firemen's Disability and Pension Fund, the Firemen's Contribution Fund, the Firemen Employers' Contribution Fund, the Firemen's Pension Reserve Fund, the Policemen's Contribution Fund, the Policemen Employers' Contribution Fund, the Policemen's Pension Reserve Fund or the Firemen and Policemen's Death Benefit Fund in any law, contract, or other document is deemed to refer to the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund, the Firefighters' Contribution Fund, the Firefighter Employers' Contribution Fund, the Firefighters' Pension Reserve Fund, the Police Officers' Contribution Fund, the Police Officer Employers' Contribution Fund, the Police Officers' Pension Reserve Fund, or the Ohio Public Safety Officers Death Benefit Fund, respectively.

There is no direct fiscal impact to either the state or political subdivisions within the state as a result of the changes contained in this bill.
