
Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill requires the appointing authorities that appoint members of district public works integrating committees to appoint alternates for those members to act in their absence. The bill specifies that if a district committee member is absent from a district or executive committee or subcommittee meeting, the alternate has the right to vote and participate in all proceedings and actions at that meeting. The meetings currently fall under the open meeting statutes and therefore any interested person may attend. However, there is no current provision in law for an individual to substitute for a member of the committee.

The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or any of its political subdivisions.
